

## MEDIA REPORTING: VIRGIN ANNOUNCEMENT EXPECTED

Overnight media have reported the likely announcement by Bain and Virgin on the road map for Virgin. Meetings will be held with TWU delegates and members to discuss the plan as soon as it is announced.

The TWU is continuing to push hard for the following demands:

- Virgin maximise the footprint of the new look Virgin to ensure as many jobs as possible are protected
- Virgin work with you and your representatives to ensure a fair and transparent workplace
- Virgin develop a plan for not just the short term, but to ensure the longevity of the company and job security of the workforce

As part of these demands we want certainty for VARA workers who continue to wait for answers. Until any announcement is made management should not introduce or trial any changes. Congratulations to delegates who have been nipping any such attempts in the bud.

*Over the coming days we'll continue our work with Virgin, Bain and other unions to ensure that job security, pay and conditions are prioritised now and into the future.
