CLEANAWAY TRYING TO SNEAK THROUGH A DODGY EA

For months now, your delegate lead TWU negotiating team has been meeting with the company to ensure that the rights, entitlements, and protections that you had with Suez, are maintained now that Cleanaway has taken over the contract on March 1 2021.

This is what the Randwick Council guaranteed to the Union before the contract went to tender in 2018.

At our last meeting with the company on Tuesday 27 July, we ended up in disagreement on more than a dozen issues. We told the company that we would oppose an EA based on what they were proposing. The company said they would consider our position and get back to us.

Until today - Wednesday 4 August, when our delegates find the company notice in the depot that the company wants to put their dodgy agreement out to vote. **What are they afraid of?**
