URGENT INFORMATION FOR MONDAY 6 SEPTEMBER SAFETY STOPPAGE

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: All companies are notified of what we are doing Monday, and have agreed to the following procedures from 8am Monday.

A 2 hour safety stoppage at the following yards on Monday 6 September, from 8am – 10am.

**CDC (Foundry Rd), Busways (Penrith), Transit Systems (Smithfield), and
Transdev (Bankstown)**

- If carrying passengers, change desto to “Set Down Only” and continue trip until pax have completed their trips.
- Contact OCC to inform them that you will be returning to the depot.
- Change desto to “Not in Service”.
- Return to depot
- Make yourself available to do other duties in the depot (not expecting that there will be any).
- Remain in the depot until 10am (complying with all COVID restrictions including wearing of facemasks and social distancing).
- There will not be physical yard meetings, we are organising an online mass meeting again (details will be sent out over the weekend).
- At 10am, present yourselves in orderly fashion, with social distancing, to the office to be allocated work for the rest of your shift.

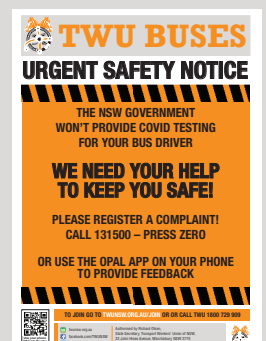
Vaccination protects us from death, serious illness and hospitalisation, but it does not protect us from being infected or transmitting the virus.
