UPDATE: CLEANAWAY WHAT A BUNCH OF LIARS

CLEANAWAY DID NOT CONSULT WITH YOU OR THE TWU ABOUT THEIR PROPOSED ENTERPRISE AGREEMENT



You should ask Cleanaway why they have not discussed their proposed EA with you.

SOME OF THE ISSUES YOU FACE:

- X** NO DISPUTE RESOLUTION CLAUSES: Cleanaway have bluntly refused to provide you access to full representation by the TWU, instead you could cop Management's justice on an issue.
- X** NO STATUS QUO CLAUSES: Status Quo means that until a dispute is resolved the Status Quo before the dispute is maintained and work will continue as before without disruption. Without this, there is power in Cleanaway's hands to push you their way.
- X** Overtime Rates being reduced.
- X** A two tier pay system, this means newer drivers will be paid less for doing the same job you do.
- X** RDOs can be cancelled by Cleanaway with only 48 hours notice, so much for plans on YOUR day off.
