The TWU is taking a stand to ensure a strong local Enterprise Agreement that secures your pay and conditions. This agreement with an increase in your Pay, Conditions and Superannuation will be backed up by a strong bus industry set of standards.

LOCAL AGREEMENT ISSUES AT PREMIER ILLAWARRA

- Surveillance Footage to only be used for notifiable events
- Communications upgrade for bus radios to ensure closed channel comms with drivers, with emergency full company facility available.
- An increase in your Pay, Conditions and Superannuation

INDUSTRY WIDE STANDARDS

- **ON-TIME RUNNING AND REALISTIC TIMETABLES:** A maximum of 4 hours driving without a 15 minute safety break, industry sign-on/ sign-off and industry-wide end of trip recovery times.
- **WORKING HOURS AND FATIGUE:** 12 hour maximum for broken shifts and minimum 10 hour break between days of work.
- **BUILDING UNION POWER:** Union clauses must be recognised by employers and strengthened.
- **INDUSTRY TRAINING:** Better and regular industry training for all drivers
- **WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY:** Safety committees and safety representatives must be maintained and strengthened.
- **WAGE INCREASES:** Same pay, conditions and entitlements for the same work across the entire bus industry.
- **SUPERANNUATION:** Extra super contributions on all earnings and get to 15% as soon as possible.



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
